Borough Manager Update – Codes Update, some properties that were same as last month are working with them on correcting violations. Council will advise Borough Manager of actual date and time and will also advise if they would like the borough manager to attend and the solicitor. Confirmation will be sent next week.

Public Works update – Patching will be done on Spring and Arch if we have left over materials from paving on Clarendon, Winter, Dartmouth and Columbus. The engineer is still working on bidding packet for the final work on Cochran and Edgewood and will advise when it is out for bid.

Penn Strategies is working with the Fire Department on multiple grants.

The council discussed moving the meeting in July to the following week due to the holiday and due to two council members not being in attendance for the July 6<sup>th</sup> meeting. The council decided to not move the meeting since they were only going to have two members absent, they still would have a quorum.

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Motion #4 was moved and seconded (Norman Cowden/Shawn Millard) that agreed to suggesting to County to take the 150,000 Liquid fuels received from the state that they distribute to all municipalities in Lycoming County to move to a grant program of giving 2 smaller municipalities 50,000 a piece and larger municipality 50,000 to equal the 150,000 they today disburse in smaller amounts.
