The area is locked; therefore, you must obtain a key from the borough office.

Update on Roadwork

COCHRAN AVE- The manhole restoration project was put on hold due to lack of bids for the project and because of material shortages from suppliers. We are working with our Borough Engineer to rebid this project for the Spring of 2022. Paving will not be completed until this restoration project is complete.

WOODSIDE & EDGEWOOD- The

borough was awarded the Dirt & Gravel grant for these two roads. The drainage and cathcbasins have been installed on these roads. There is some finalized stone work that will be completed this year. 2022 the roads will go out for bid for DSA placement on the road surface.
